## Applicant Requirements

- ✓ Enrolled in an accredited college or university pursuing a bachelor's degree in Engineering, Science or Systems Engineering (STEM-related fields)
- ✓ Available to work at NASA JSC a minimum of 15 weeks during the fall or spring
- ✓ Limited Summer internships are also available for minimum of 10 weeks. Please contact for more information
- ✓ US Citizen and Minimum GPA of 3.0



## Cost to Your College/ University

JSC requests that Space Grant Consortia provide students with a \$600 per week stipend and round-trip travel expenses. For your investment, you will receive:

- ✓ The opportunity for your student to gain a semester-long practical experience in applying principles and theories learned in the classroom
- ✓ Career development for your student
- ✓ Strengthened affiliation between your university and NASA
